

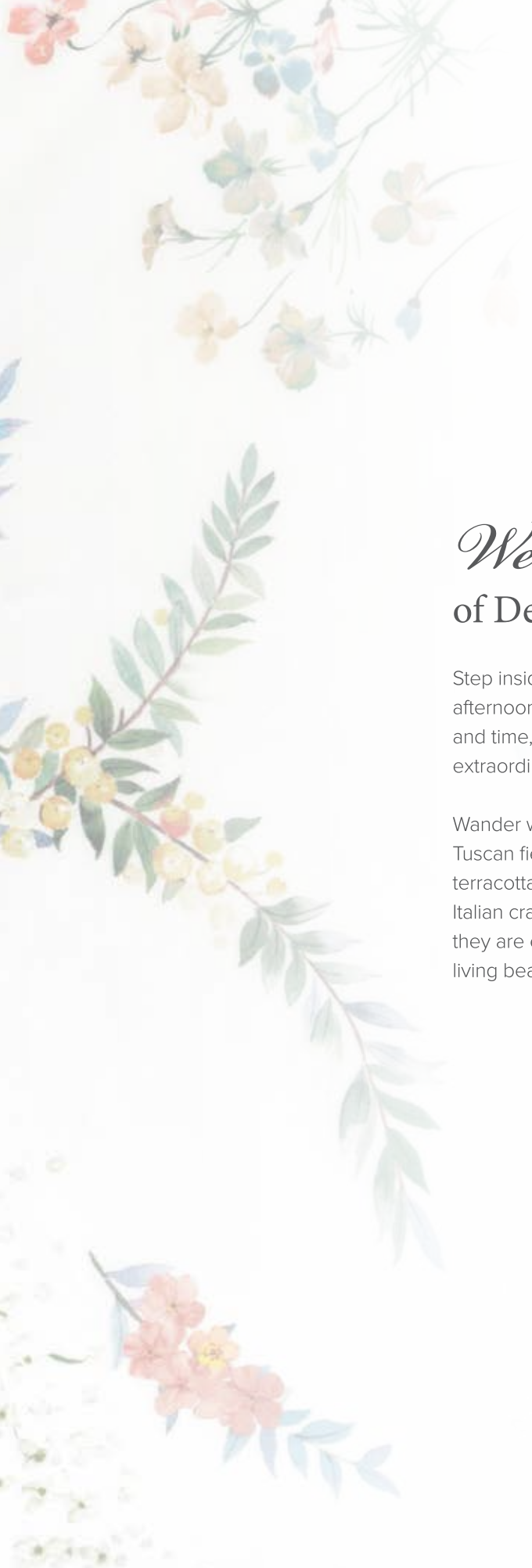

The story of *Italian Excellence*

Our story begins with a determined young woman with a vision.

Dea Mantellassi started as an apprentice in the world of textiles, driven by the ambition to create the most refined linens in the world.

Obsessed with fine fabrics and embroideries under pioneering Florentine designer Emilia Bellini, she honed her eye and hand. Dea would eventually launch her own label in the 1960s—transforming artistic mastery into an internationally recognized luxury house for bed, bath and table linens.

A workshop was born in the heart of the Tuscan countryside, gathering the finest local artisans — masters of cutting, sewing, and embroidery — and the most precious fabrics. In this harmony between tradition and innovation, each piece became the purest expression of authentic Italian luxury.

Today, all collections are produced entirely in Tuscany, between Pistoia and the Chianti countryside, where generations of artisans preserve rare finishing and embroidery techniques. Each piece is meticulously overseen from material selection through final packaging to ensure exceptional quality.

Still family-run, Dea Italian Luxury Linens continues to be led by our founder, and daughter Sabrina, guiding the brand's international expansion, and a passionate, dedicated team — from design to production to sales -- is the beating heart.

Deeply rooted in Italian heritage yet attuned to global sensibilities, Dea stands as a true ambassador of Italian culture and craftsmanship worldwide.





Our design *inspirations*

Drawing from the warmth of the Tuscan campagna and the enduring grandeur of Italy's ancient cities, the season's collections layer painterly botanicals, nuanced color, and sculptural forms into a refined expression of Italian craftsmanship and couture-inspired artistry.

A palette of sun-faded ochre, moss green, chocolate brown, burnished plum, inky blue, and rich earthen tones unfold throughout— colors layered and melded as though weathered by centuries of light and heat beneath the Chianti sun.

The techniques that Dea has perfected over generations—breathtaking embroideries, inspired prints, sculptural borders, and dimensional jacquards and quilts—come together in our key stories, creating iconic designs that are timeless and modern, and deeply enchanting.

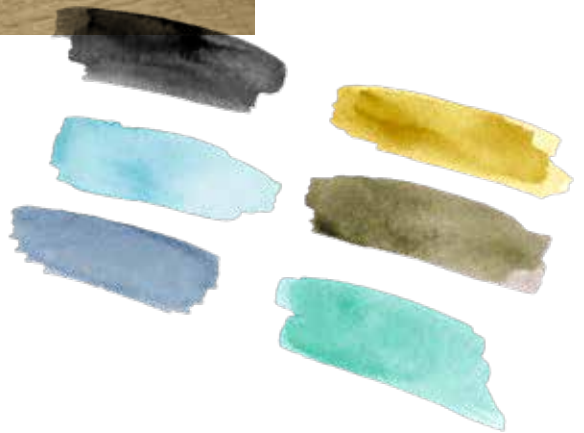
